ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: National Certificate Vocational at NQF level 4

A National Certificate (Vocational) with a bachelor's degree or a diploma endorsement, with at least 50% for English (home language or first additional language) and 40% for Mathematics or 50% for Mathematical Literacy, 40% for Life Orientation (excluded for APS calculation) and 50% for any other three compulsory vocational subjects.

Selection criteria: APS=24 (excl. Life Orientation).

RLP PROCESS:

"Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)" means the principles and processes through which the prior knowledge and skills of a person are made visible, mediated and assessed for the purposes of alternative access and admission, recognition and certification, or further learning and development.

Applications for RPL must be submitted at least six (6) months prior to the intended date of registration
